Leader: People of God, we hope in the Lord, for with the Lord there is unfailing love.

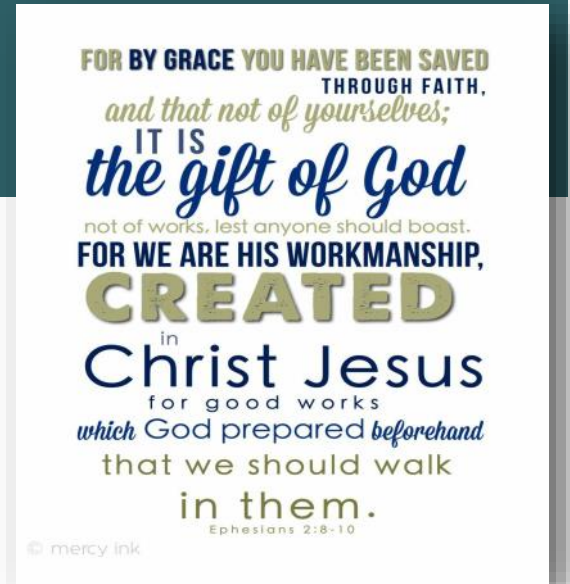
People: God's redemption overflows and leads us to a future with hope and purpose.
